On May 10, 2019 the Participants of the CAT NMS, LLC and FINRA CAT LLC published the Version 2.0 of the *CAT Reporting Industry Member Reporting Scenarios* document. This version incorporates industry feedback received since the publication Version 1.1 on March 29, 2019.

- Reorganized the existing scenarios within the document and created new sections for:

 - Electronic Duplicate Scenarios
 - Child Order Scenarios
 - Clearing Firm Scenarios
 - Option Internal Route and Child Order Scenarios
 - Complex Option Order Scenarios

- Removed Scenario 3.2.1 (an options representative order scenario)
