# Phase 2a/2b Spec – Clarifications

---

- ▶ Clarified in MEIR/MOIR events that *parentOrderID* is required when *parentOrderKeyDate* is populated.
- ▶ Clarified that when *representativeInd* value 'YF' is used, *aggregatedOrders* must be blank.
- ▶ Clarified that when *fulfillmentLinkType* value 'YF' is used, firm side details must be blank.

# Phase 2a/2b Spec – Corrections

---

- ▶ Corrected Data Type Text to support ASCII characters from 32 to 126. Previous versions included ASCII character 127 (DELETE). The restriction on using the delimiters (comma, pipe, double quote and @) remains.
- ▶ Corrected CSV examples in section 7.6.1.
- ▶ Corrected feedback provided for unlinked events reported by the CAT Reporter in section 7.5.1.

# Phase 2a/2b Spec – Content Changes

---

- ▶ Eliminated *handlingInstructions* values ‘WCO’ and ‘PSO’.
- ▶ Eliminated the archive folder and feature of archiving FTP submissions for 10 days in Section 6.3.1.
- ▶ Updated Sections 7.1.2 and 7.5 to indicate that when no Linkage Errors are found in Linkage Discovery, an empty file will be returned with the filename ending in .success.

# Phase 2c Spec

---

- ▶ Clarified definition of *newOrderFDID* field in accordance with new FAQ B46 “The FDID of the related New Order event, if available in the booking system.”
- ▶ Deferred orderID uniqueness requirements on MEIR.
- ▶ Removed *handlingInstruction* ‘RQR’.
- ▶ Requirements for RFQ Responses will be finalized by the end of February.

# Scenarios Document

---

- ▶ v2.5 of the scenarios document is still being finalized. Planned updates for v2.5 are:
  - Industry Member Acting in a Mixed Capacity
  - Unsolicited Cancellation of a Customer Order by an Exchange
  - Representative Order Executed as a Result of a Negotiation
  - Fill of a Customer Order at a Previously Displayed Quote
  - Industry Member Cancels a Proprietary Order Previously Routed to an Exchange
  - New section for Liquidation of Fractional Share Scenarios
  - New Section for Floor Broker scenarios with the addition of CBOE Floor Broker Scenarios.
- ▶ RFQ Response scenarios are currently planned for v2.6.
- ▶ Phase 2c scenarios document will be published after the Phase 2c IM Tech Spec is published.
